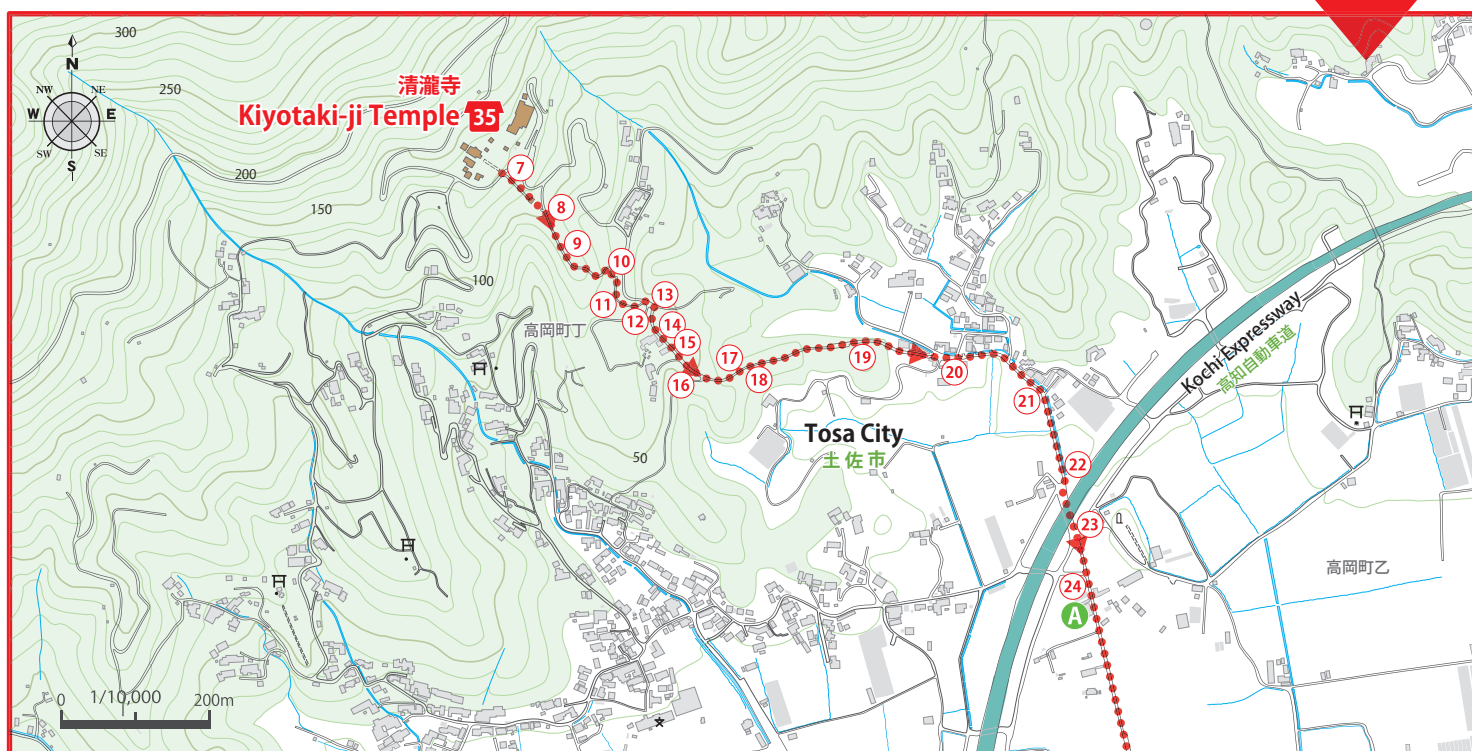
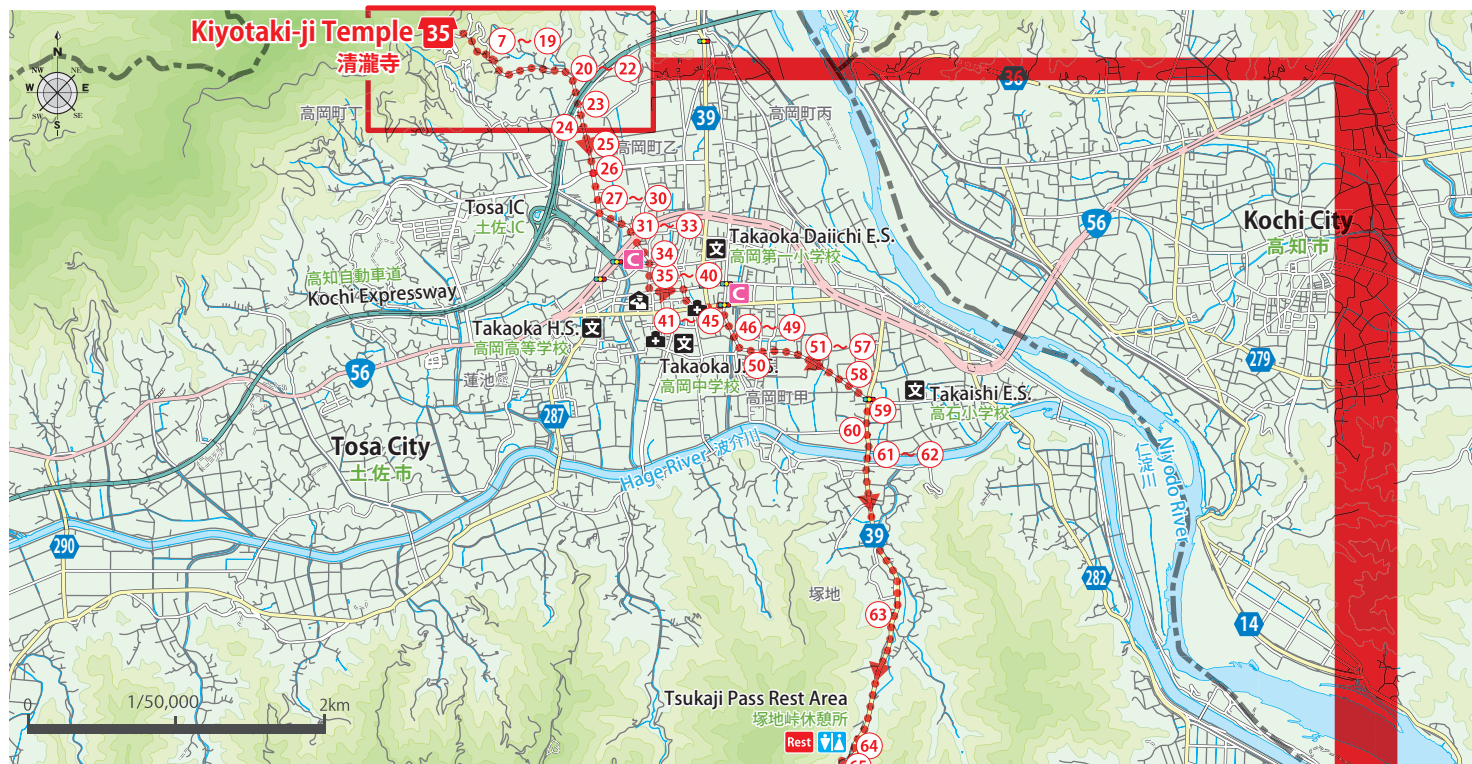


【Kiyotaki-ji Temple - Tsukaji Pass (8.5km)】

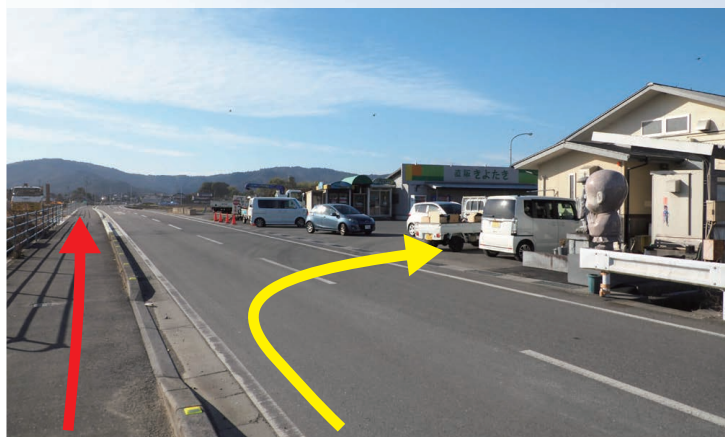

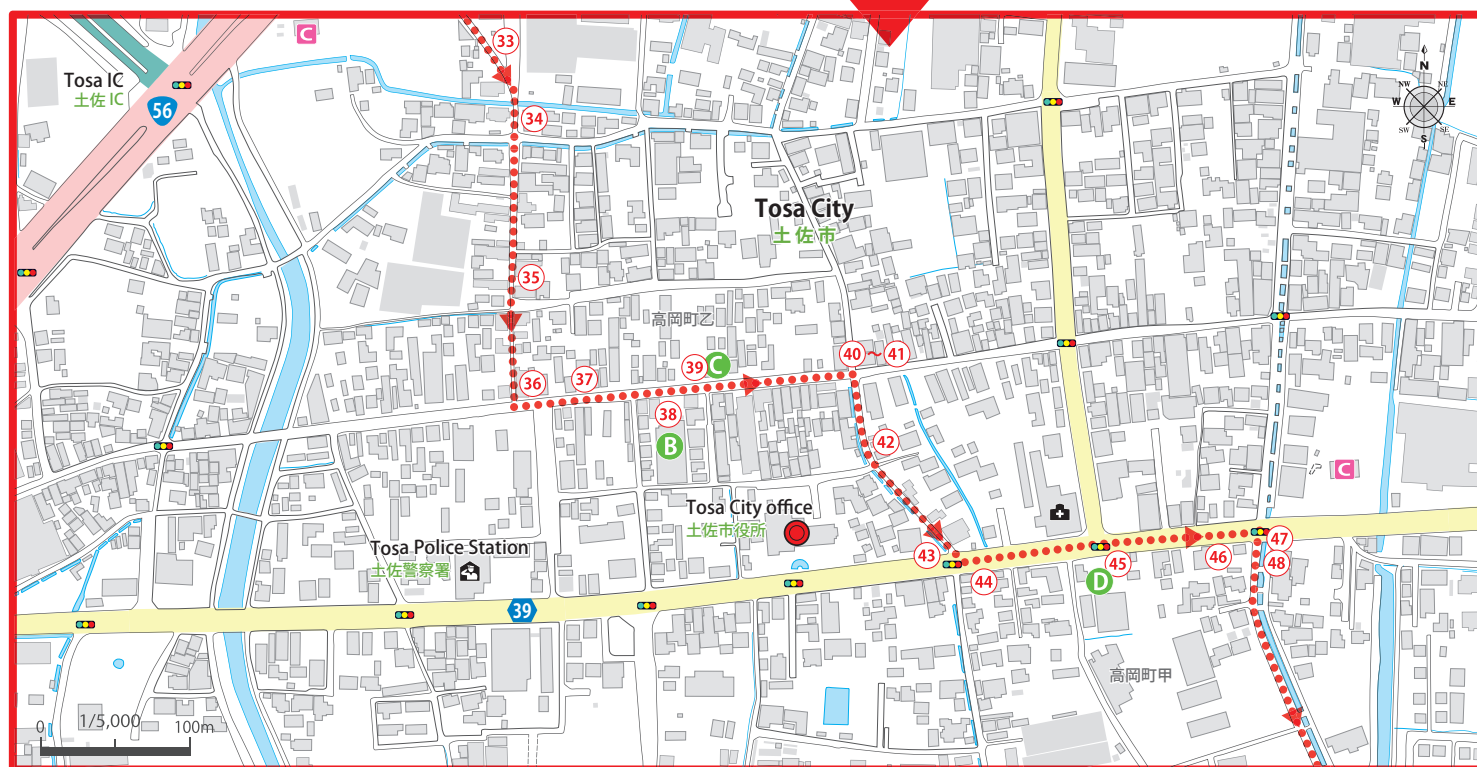
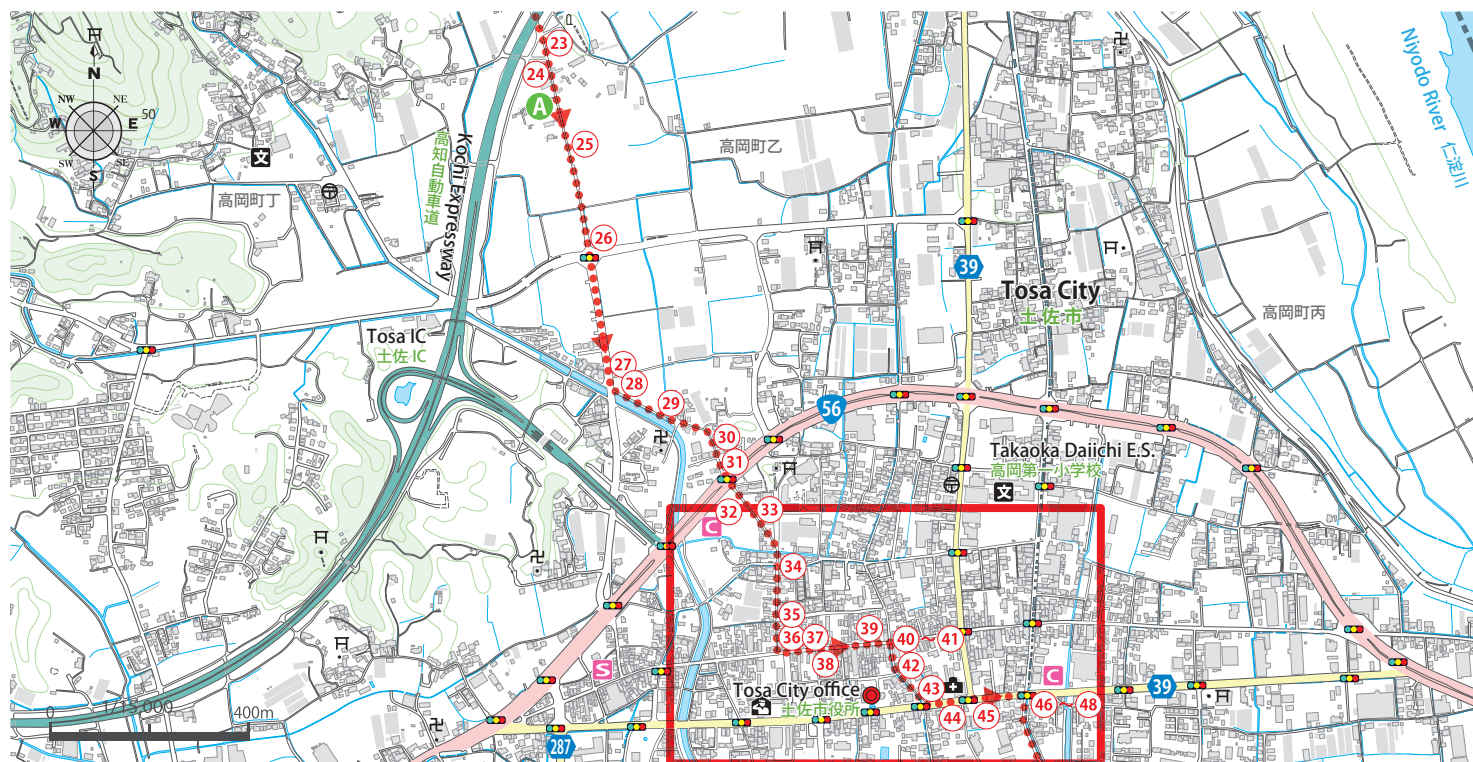


Sanuki Udon Kiyotaki's system

3. Receive the udon you ordered
4. Pay
5. If you order kake udon, you will only receive noodles, and need to pour your own dashi soup by yourself from the dashi tank.
6. Add toppings such as green onions and grated ginger etc.
7. Eat at any table available
8. Return tableware

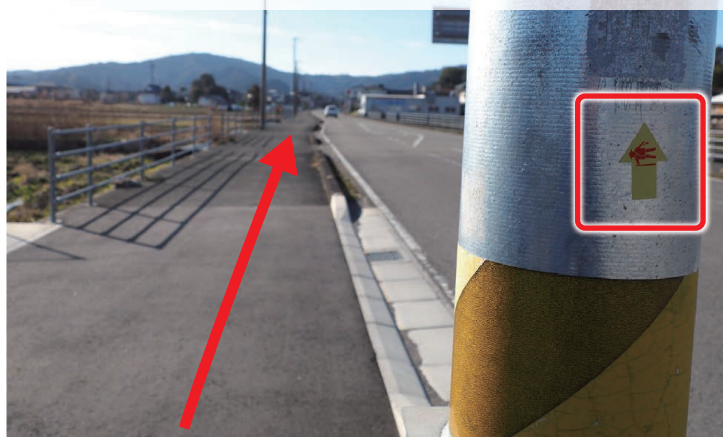
