


【Rest Hut Fujiyu-an – Iwamoto-ji Temple (5km)】




89 Merge with Route 56 and cross the crosswalk on the right.



90 Cross the crosswalk and turn left.



91 Go straight on Route 56.



92 Guest house 40010



93 Go straight for about 3 km on Route 56.



94 Go straight.



95 Convenience store (Lawson)



96 Go straight. If you turn right, you will find the Aguri Kubokawa roadside rest area.

97 There is a restroom and a store at Yuingu Shimanto.  



98 At the three-way junction, turn left and cross the crosswalk.



99 Ignore the signpost and go straight until you reach the tunnel.



100 Turn left before the tunnel and proceed to Yobizaka Pass.



101 Cross the bridge and go straight.






102 Cross the paved road and continue downhill.



103 Go down the hill and turn right.



104 Turn left at the intersection.



105 At the three-way intersection, turn right.



Go straight, following the sign board and stone signpost.



106 Go straight.

Iwamoto-ji Temple (岩本寺)

Brief History of Iwamoto-ji Temple

The predecessor to this temple was built by the monk Gyoki in the Tenpyo era (729-749). Kukai later visited the area in the early 9th century and built 5 shrines and 5 temples. Eventually the principal image of each temple was gathered in what is now Iwamoto-ji. This temple has 575 paintings gathered from all over the country displayed on the ceiling of its main hall. The art varies wildly in style from Western paintings to Japanese chigiri-e collages. Motifs are also diverse, ranging from the Buddha to Marilyn Monroe.
